Support For Sight was created in 2013 to help go above what the Lions and Lioness clubs could do on their own. **Our hope is to someday be self supporting to create an ongoing legacy for our area. We need to realize that this isn't an easy cash resource, we are building a self-sustaining legacy for our children, our future generations.**

The way we set it up is that the person needing assistance fills out a form, the board discusses it, then we send it to the Community Foundation of North Central Wisconsin, since they are a 501C3, and they send the money to the doctor, medical facility, etc., but we do not send directly to the person. It keeps it all legal.

We are covering all of Vilas and Iron counties and would welcome any Lion or Lioness clubs in this area to join us.

We meet at Community Center in Boulder Junction, just ask your representative from your club, or call me at 715-543-2669. Anyone may attend any of the meetings. All are welcome. We would like a representative nominated from each club wishing to join our board.

We have narrowed our fundraisers to a Golf golf outing in June in Mercer at the Lynx Lake Golf Club and a Polka Party in March, at the Boulder Junction Community Center! Please join us!

We are doing a meat raffle for the first time ever at Sportmans Chalet in Eagle River January 28th.

While we were not going to actually do a fundraiser for anyone's benefit, in 2015, at the Musky Days and Loon Days, we did sell cookies for Lelyn and in March we had a polka party and donated the proceeds, which was \$3200 to the Seeing for Lelyn trust fund.
